Regatta # 1 was hosted by Canberra Girls Grammar and from all reports the Regatta went very smoothly and all had a good time.

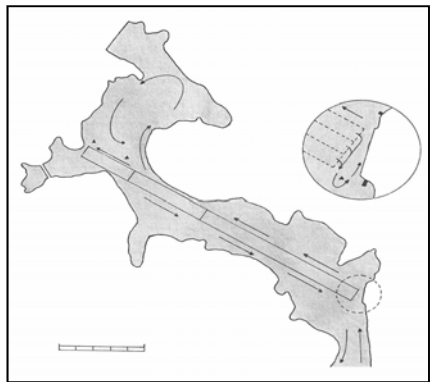
Thanks must go to all the BRO's who assisted. The

Capital Lakes has made a great start to the Season taking top spot after the first Regatta on the Premiership standings.

CLRC topped the standings ahead of last years overall winners Canberra Rowing Club who were just four points behind.

Gippsland Grammar school made the long trip from Victoria and had a big impact on results taking third spot overall on the standings.

ANU boat Club

are the most noticeable improvers on last year scoring 21 premiership points not far from their entire total last year.

The Women's Premiership Capital Lakes showed their strength with a five point lead over CRC but Lake Tuggeranong are close behind CRC on 20 points just nudging out Hosts of Regatta #1 Canberra Girls Grammar.

The Men's premiership is being lead by Gippsland Grammar with 25

points just ahead of Canberra Grammar School on 22 points.

ANU were strong in the Men's with 17 points in third

Crossing the course

during racing is prohibited and crew are generally disqualified.

You must go around the end of the course before heading to the start

line. You must also give way to finishing crews on the course at the finish line when crossing towards the start line.
