

ISRA Regatta: Canberra, 20 - 21 February 2010

The Canberra rowing schools welcome all visiting schools and their supporters to the 2010 ISRA Regatta. A map of the rowing course flow is attached as is a UBD map of the area.

Parking

Parking arrangements have changed near the regatta site. There is NO PARKING along the lake side of Lady Denman Drive. There are 'No Parking' signs erected and parking inspectors will be present. The best place to park will be in one of the several parking areas along Black Mountain Peninsular on Garry Owen Drive.

There is also some parking available to the west of the finish line area on the western side of Acacia Inlet (see map).

Shuttle Bus

A shuttle bus will run from the northern end of Garry Owen drive near Preston Place on the Black Mountain Peninsular to the finish line area.

Traffic

Lady Denman Drive is a busy 80km/hr road. To help with making the area safer, we have applied for a change in speed limit to be put in place along the regatta finish line area. We are waiting for final approval, but at the time of writing, this approval has not arrived. We are however, confident it will be granted.

Bicycle path

There is a bicycle path which runs through the top side of the spectator area. This path will be sign posted and will also be barricaded for the safety of cyclists and spectators. Please only use the crossing points that will be in place.

Boat Trailers

The gate to the grassed area will not be opened until after 2:00pm on Friday afternoon, however, boat trailers are NOT allowed down on the grassed area. Boats are to be unloaded up the top and walked down the short distance. Boat Trailers can be parked in the car park area above the finish line on the concrete island. Once this area is full, please tow your empty trailer to a parking area on either Black Mountain Peninsular on Garry Owen Drive or in the parking area to the west of the finish line - approximately 500m away.

School Tents

All school tents must be erected above the bicycle path.

Boat Storage

There is limited fixed boat storage at the finish line area. Schools should bring enough trestles on which to store their boats.

Services

There will be a variety of food and drinks available over the weekend. This will be positioned at the finish line. Viper Sportwear will have a stall.

There will be first aid station situated behind the food area. There will be on-water rescue and first aid services provided as well.

Toilets and water will be situated in the car park area above the finish line.

Medals

Medals will be handed out from the commentators tent. They will be available once official results are published.

Finals

The draw for finals will be available at the end of Saturday's racing. Parts of the draw may be available earlier. The full finals draw will also be placed on the ACT Rowing website <http://www.rowingact.org.au>

School Contacts

Each school should give a school contact name and mobile phone number to the regatta secretary so contact can be easily made during the course of the regatta if necessary.

Regatta Secretary

All regatta secretary services, coxswain weigh in, bow number rental etc will be available at the BRO shelter on the finish line.

Maps of the finish line area and a course flow diagram are are next two pages.

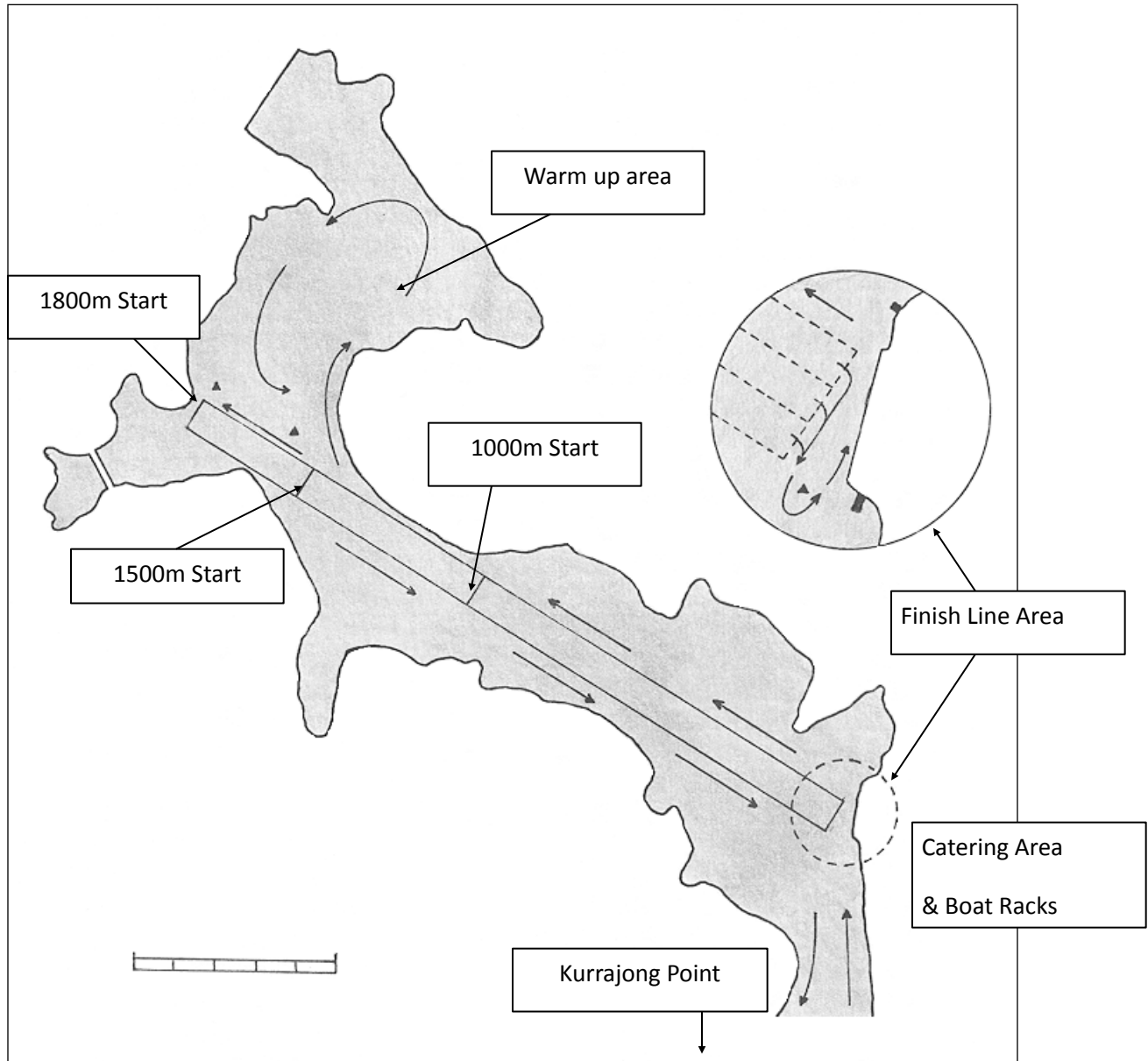
ACT Rowing Course Maps

Course Boating Instructions



Special Note to crews boating from Weston Park

Please ensure that you following the correct boat flow as shown above. You should boat only from the beach area on the 'big bend' at Kurrajong Point, at the northern end of Weston Park Road.

If tinnies are coming across to the finish line area, please take a wide berth and moor tinnies next to the floating pontoon at the eastern end of the finish line area. Do not allow any tinnies to cross in front of the finish line or go to the finish line jetty.
