

2026 ACT Interstate Team Selection Processes

Masters Crews:

Masters crews should nominate as a full crew and complete the selection requirements as a full crew. Crews must meet the 'D' Age Category for racing, with crews not meeting the D category not considered for selection.

Nominated crews must follow all guidelines, policies and rules laid out in the Interstate Selection Policy and be able to compete at the 2026 Australian Masters Rowing Championships in Perth, Western Australia.
